Statement of Faith

Online Admissions/Enrollment

Online Admissions Instructions

We are honored that you have chosen Hillsborough Christian Academy to meet the educational needs of your children. In order to proceed with our application process, please make note of the following steps:

- 1. Schedule an Admissions Visit with our Admissions Team.
- 2. Complete the online application found at www.hillsboroughchristian.org (Select Admissions and Apply Online) by creating an admissions account (instructions included).
- 3. Upload copies of paper documents (Birth Certificate, Immunization, etc).
- 4. Complete Academic Review (may include placement testing).

Once the admissions process has been completed, you will receive communication from our office regarding your child's acceptance status. If accepted, you can begin the enrollment process.

Online Enrollment Instructions

To access the Enrollment Packet:

- 1. Create a Family Portal account (information included)
- 2. After logging in to FACTS Family Portal, click on Family Information in the left menu.
- 3. Click on Enrollment/Reenrollment.
- 4. Click on Start Enrollment. Our Online Enrollment system will open with a link to the enrollment packet for your child.
- 5. Continue through each screen filling in any required information. Much of the information will be prepopulated from the current record. If you find something that needs to be changed, (i.e., cell phone number, email address, emergency contact, etc.) click on the space with the incorrect information and enter in the new information. The bottom of each page has a place to click Save & Next.
- 6. Upon completion and review of the information, you will submit enrollment.
- 7. You will receive a confirmation email that your enrollment is complete. If you do not receive a confirmation email from our Admissions Office within 24 hours, please contact us.

The online process should take approximately 20 minutes to complete. Your information will be saved if you need to quit and come back later.



Creating a Family Portal Account

If you have other students already attending Hillsborough Christian Academy, please use your existing Family Portal login.

Instructions for Creating a Family Portal Login:

- 1. Please go to www.hillsboroughchristian.org
- 2. Click on Parents in the navigation menu.
- 3. After the FACTS SIS Family Portal Login screen opens, please select Create New Family Portal Account.
- 4. Enter HB-NC into the District Code field.
- 5. Enter in the Email field your email address as provided in your application to the school.
- 6. Click the Create Account button.

You will receive an email from FACTS Customer Support containing a link that will allow you to create your username and password. For security purposes, the link will remain active for 6 hours.

- 1. Please click on the link. A Change/Create Password screen will open. You may use the default username provided, or create a new username. Then type in your desired password into the Password field and Confirm Field.
- 2. Click on the Save Username and/or Password button.
- 3. Close the window. Once you have created a user account, you can login at any time by going to the link on our homepage.

Tuition and Fees (2024 – 2025 School Year)

Providing a Christian education is one of the best decisions a parent can make for their children. Therefore, we aim to be as affordable as possible while providing an excellent classroom environment, high quality curriculum, and engaging activities for HCA students.

Application Fees \$75.00 per Student

A non-refundable application fee is due at the time of initial application. This fee is paid online by the parent upon submission of the application. A family may request to have the application fee waived by requesting a waiver from the school office.

Enrollment Fees \$200.00 per Student

New Student Enrollment will be processed for students only if the Enrollment Fee is paid.
